COLLEGE Lock of the Week: Georgia Tech -9%

There have been two common opponents between these teams: Virginia beat North Carolina by 6 and lost to Pittsburgh by 17 while Georgia Tech beat Carolina by 26 and Pitt by 18. While the Yellow Jackets' other ACC games have been against solid competition in Miami, Wake Forest and Clemson, Virginia has beaten Duke (1-5 in ACC) and lost by 31 at home to Boston College (3-3 in ACC). Georgia Tech has gone 8-1 ATS as a favorite since the start of last season, and it wouldn't be surprising to see the Yellow Jackets win by more than twice the amount of this point spread.

SUNDAY NIGHT Pick of the Week: Oakland -3

In games between conference opponents where the line is between +3 and -3, teams that have gone under the total by more than 34 combined points total over their previous five games are 12-37-1 ATS since the start of the 2013 season. Miami has scored more than 20 points in a game only once this season, and the Dolphins' running game took a hit when on Tuesday the team dealt leading rusher Jay Ajayi to the Eagles. It's hard to envision Miami scoring enough to keep the final outcome of this one within a single score.

NFL Lock of the Week: Arizona -1%

Road teams averaging 17 or fewer points per game are 48-19-3 ATS since the start of the 2008 season after having allowed 30 or more points in their previous game. While San Francisco is 0-10 ATS since the start of last season against teams that are allowing an average of at least 235 passing yards per game, the Cardinals are 11-2 ATS under current head coach Bruce Arians after having allowed 400 or more total yards in their previous game. The 49ers are also 1-8 ATS since the start of 2015 when coming off back-to-back games in which they allowed more than 24 points.

MONDAY NIGHT Pick of the Week: Detroit -2%

The Packers are 0-7 ATS at home since the start of the 2015 season when facing teams that are allowing an average of at least 5.65 yards per play, and that's been with star quarterback Aaron Rodgers under center. With Rodgers out, Brett Hundley completed 12-of-25 passes for 87 yards, zero touchdowns and an interception in Green Bay's 26-17 Week 7 home loss to New Orleans. Huntley would have to improve drastically in his second NFL start if Green Bay stands a chance against one of its divisional rivals.
